

A Note about IEW curriculum: Parents, please be aware that the IEW curriculum has changed. They've updated, revamped, and rebranded it as Structure & Style for Students. It still comes in Levels A, B, & C with a Year 1 and Year 2 at each level. Your child's reading level is what determines which level he/she should be doing. Generally, Level A is grades 3-5; Level B is grades 6-8; Level C is grades 9-12. However, these guidelines are very flexible so that parents can ultimately decide which is most suitable for their own children.

You can access the first 3 weeks of lessons of each level for free if you go to <https://iew.com/> and click on the scrolling box that says "A Helpful Hand for Home-based Instruction: Free Language Arts Lessons from IEW". There you will find instructions for accessing the lessons. By reading the source texts - or having your child read the source text - in those lessons, you can determine where your child would be most successful. Keep in mind that you want the reading to be EASY for your child so that he/she can focus on writing instruction. (Source texts are the paragraphs provided in the curriculum.)

If your child has had IEW before and you fear him/her doing the same thing over again and getting bored, the folks at IEW have advised us not to worry about that. Since the material is all new and the curriculum includes more than the old, it is very appropriate for students to do the same level again. For instance, if your child has had SWI-B, then it will work very well for him to take SSS-B.
